NIH Form Changes

NIH revised the forms and released them in 11/04. GrantSlam 6.1.5 incorporates both the physical changes and the accounting policy changes for the PHS 398 and 2590. The GrantSlam upgrade process will move your Profile and Proposal data forward to this latest version.

The form changes are incorporated for new versions of:

- Traditional
- Modular
- RCA
- NRSA.



Electronic Submission to NIH (PC only)

Have it both ways. GrantSlam continues to support paper submission, but adds secure electronic submission for modular PHS 398 proposals. You can continue to use your existing local approval process, while learning the electronic submission ropes. Electronic Submission access is now generally available for simple competing grant applications with these characteristics:

- R01, R03, or R21
- Modular budgets
- No consortia/subcontracts
- Allowed application types
 - New (Type 1 not Revised)
 - Competing continuations (Type 2)
 - Revised (New and Competing Continuations)
